



Y Bala Town, River and Lake Path

Route Overview

- Distance: 3.2km
- Duration: 1 hour
- Route type: Circular

Before you start

Read the safety and route grading information on the Snowdonia National Park Authority website before you start your journey.

Make your way to the tarmac footpath located behind the Warden's Office at the Llyn Tegid foreshore. There are numerous access points leading up to the footpath from the car park.



Follow the footpath along the lakeshore. Take a seat on the benches on your right-hand side to enjoy the views across the lake towards Llanuwchllyn.



When you reach a Public Right of Way footpath on your left-hand side, continue forward. Do not follow the Public Right of Way footpath.



Follow the path to the right as you pass the rugby fields.



Turn right when you reach the road and follow the pavement for approximately 150 meters until you reach the main road.



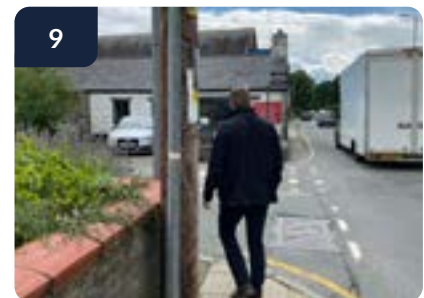
Carefully cross the road and go through the gate that leads you onto the flood bank. Follow the path along the flood bank, past where the river Tryweryn joins the river Dyfrdwy.



Bear left and continue to follow the path along the river.



You will reach a gate by the main road's bridge. Go through the gate and turn left, following the pavement through Y Bala's high street.



When you reach the garage, turn left down Aran Street and continue along the street until you reach a car park.



Turn right at the end of the car park, following the signs towards Llyn Tegid.



Go through the gate that leads across the fields. Follow the path across the fields until you reach the lakeshore path. Turn right to head back to the Llyn Tegid car park.
